### **TT126/2022 Apologies**

### **TT127/2022 Minutes**

The minutes of the meetings held on 21 March 2023 were approved and signed by Town Team Chair Phil Wisdom.

### **TT128/2022 Heritage Buildings Project**

Consultation event feedback – Hayhurst had advised that the event was reasonably well attended, a lot of ‘historical’ feedback was received, the children’s exhibit promoted interest as did the three proposed strategies. Unfortunately, at the consultation event some attendees seemed under the impression that they had been invited to voice their opinion on the future of the buildings rather than assess and provide constructive comment on the expert led three proposed solutions for efficient use of the buildings.

It was agreed that images of the three strategies with covering text supplied by Chair Wisdom should be uploaded to the website and that the Council should be instructed to make the next stage payment to Hayhurst of £5,400 plus Vat. It was further decided that discussion of the draft report should be an agenda item for the May Town Team Meeting.

**TT130/2022 Website**
